

## **JOB VACANCY FOR MARINE MAINTENANCE ASSISTANT**

A Summer Student position is open under the Canada Student Summer Grant Program

Candidates must be between 15-30 years of age AND have attended school in 2017 and returning to school in the fall of 2018. Validation will be required.

Hours & Wages: Minimum of 30 hours per week for a minimum of 8 weeks paid at minimum wage or higher dependent of skills and qualifications.

Start Date: Immediately but no later than July 9, 2018

Job Description: For a student to work as a marine assistant at the Bay of Quinte Yacht Club (BQYC). As a maintenance assistant, the applicant will be provided basic training in the maintenance and upkeep of club sailboats that are used for sail training at BQYC.

This will involve, but will not be limited to:

- working with basic hand and power tools used for wood working,
- fiberglass repair techniques (both polyester and epoxy),
- basic outboard motor maintenance, fuel storage and mixtures,
- swaging of fittings, inventory of parts and order forms for parts
- use of rope knots to secure boats and marine items,
- knowledge of names of boat parts and equipment, and
- Inventory, log keeping, inspections and damage reporting will also be required
- ensuring coach boats are cleaned, fueled & operational on a daily basis
- launch area free of debris and assisting with launching of boats as needed
- maintain a clean working and teaching area.

Duties will also include providing assistance to the club's grounds director such as moving boats, assisting with docking visiting boats. The candidate will be responsible to the Fleet Captain Dinghy and Sail Training, reporting directly to the Fleet Manager.

The ideal candidate would have background in shop techniques or have taken the Canadian Power Squadron or equivalent course or experience in marine maintenance. Trade or Apprenticeships.

In-Service Health & Safety Training will be provided to the applicant.

Due to summer camp activities which involve youth, the successful applicant will be required to submit a current criminal reference check for vulnerable sector (from your local police).

Pre-requisite: Pleasure Craft Operators Certificate (PCOC) & a Transport of Canada approved lifejacket.
