
## 2017 Wills Cup -- Sailing Instructions:

Wills Cup will be run in Big Bay on Sunday July 23rd.

Team Mako (Thomas Wager) will be RC on Wally. There will also be a mark boat.

Forecast is East Wind for Sunday. Give yourself at least 1 hour to get to Big Bay. Recommend you leave the dock by noon.

- The first start will be approximately 1:30PM.
- There will be 3 starts as usual in order Div1/Div2 -- Sharks -- Div3
- Course will be windward-Leeward using an offset mark and leeward gate.
- The marks will be large inflatable cylinders and/or inflatable triangles and/or balls.
- Windward mark will be buoys to port.
- Boats must also go around the offset mark buoys to port.
- Boats can go around either mark at the leeward gate per the course diagram below.
- Start / finish line will be set up below the gate.
- There are no restrictions regarding going through the gate on the starting or finishing legs
- Committee boat will display at the start a number 1, 2, or 3 indicating the planned number of Laps.
- RC may also shorten course if necessary so watch for the shorten course flag.
- RC will be monitoring VHF channel 71
